MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

II. Mutual Covenants

- 4. Both the Parties shall be responsible to provide each other with complete, accurate, timely and relevant information and to carry out any other obligations to run the program successfully. In addition, both the Parties shall keep each other informed of any material developments or proposals relating to the said program, which may have a bearing on the engagements between the Parties.
- 5. It is agreed by both the Parties that with respect to the confidential information and IPRs they shall:
- a. Protect the confidential information and IPRs in a reasonable and appropriate manner as prescribed under law and in accordance with the applicable professional standards.
